You might ask, preparation for what? Part of the answer is the celebration of Easter. But in another sense Lent is about joining Christ in his death, so that we can also join him in new life.

Look at Romans 6. Paul begins by answering the question "Shall we go on sinning..." Of course his answer is an emphatic NO. But he explains his answer in a surprising way. He says we should not sin for we have been joined to Jesus' death.

Ro. 6:3,4 "Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ were baptized into his death?...(in order that) we too may live a new life." Paul is telling us that a new union has been formed when we were joined to Christ by faith. We believe in Christ, so we are joined to Christ. And being joined to Christ means we are joined to his death. He died FOR sin, and we die TO sin. And so Paul goes on to command "... count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ" (Ro. 6:11)

Lent is a season meant to help us experience our connection with Christ. We have died to sin, so we rise to a new life.

Not long ago I heard an interview with a man who had written a book called *Ten Days Without*. He said he had always heard he should care for the poor, but never found a way to have real compassion. When he heard a presentation about not having shoes, he decided to try it. He would live for 10 days without shoes. (I don't think he did it in March in northwestern PA.)

He said the experience changed him because it allowed him "to walk in another person's shoes" for awhile (yes, pun intended). The discipline of living without helped him identify with others and so changed his life.

Lent is like that. It asks us to change our lives for 40 days. It asks us to be more consistent in our spiritual disciplines of worship, prayer and Bible reading. It does this because changing what we do has a profound impact on who we are, and who we are becoming. Lent is not magic. But God does work his grace in us when we seek him. Lent is about that pursuit.

So how might you do something different?

Try Fasting

- Read through the Gospel of Mark. I'm preaching each week from that Gospel so it would be a good connection.
- Keep a prayer journal

Change is good. Lent allows God to change us.
