

I am convinced there is a desperate need in the church for the Holy Spirit of God to be given room to have his way!

One of the things we need to examine is how we think about and relate to the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was telling his disciples about his upcoming death, he encouraged them that "another Advocate" was coming (John 14:16). In fact, Jesus says that it is to their advantage that he is going away so that the Holy Spirit can come. After his resurrection, Jesus tells his disciples to wait in Jerusalem where they will receive the Holy Spirit. Then, in Acts 2, this is fulfilled as the power of Holy Spirit is unleashed upon the newly birthed church.

So, what does the Holy Spirit have to do with the church, today? EVERYTHING! He is so important that we will be spending the month of June studying him during Sunday worship and in a Wednesday Bible study. Let me help us prepare by sharing what it means for us to believe in the Holy Spirit and live in his presence.

The Holy Spirit gives the Church authority. He is not merely an invisible force. The Holy Spirit is the authoritative, empowering presence of the Living God. You see, the Gospel doesn't stop at the cross or even with the resurrection of Jesus. The Gospel continues to unfold in the coming of the Spirit at Pentecost. With his presence and power, the Holy Spirit enables the church to witness to our faith.

The Holy Spirit empowers the Church for our mission. In Acts 1, Jesus prepares his followers for the coming of the Holy Spirit. He reminds them to stay in Jerusalem until they have been "baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 1:5). This baptism will empower the Church for mission and ministry. Do you know that almost one billion people across the globe have never heard the good news of Jesus Christ? The Spirit still calls us into global mission and ministry.

The Holy Spirit shows the New Creation. The ministry of the church is to reflect the ministry of Jesus. The Holy Spirit shows us the future reality of God's Kingdom breaking into our circumstances. When the Holy Spirit comes, people are healed, reconciled, delivered, given hope, convicted of sin, and brought closer to Jesus.

Let's pray, especially this month, that we are filled even more with the presence of the Holy Spirit.

GRACE CHURCH JUNE SOAP READINGS

Using the SOAP method of Bible reading can keep us on the disciple's pathway. You're invited and encouraged to use the following Bible passages each day of the month. Here's a quick reminder of SOAP.

- **S** Scripture. Use the ones listed on the calendar
- **O** Observation. What is God speaking through these verses? What do these verses mean? What do you observe in your reading? Jot these observations in a journal or notebook.
- A Application. How does what you read apply to your life, right now? What is God saying to you? What principles can you apply to your life today?
- P Prayer. Close the time in prayerful conversation with God. Thank him for what you learned and for how this applies to you right now.

During June, we will read through Scripture about the person and work of the Holy Spirit. The third person of the Trinity has a specific role to play in the life of a Jesus follower.

The Life Center

My body-My choice; That seems to be the abortion rights battle cry that is being sounded around the country and sometimes around the world. That certainly is true but isn't it bigger than that? Grace has chosen the "encourage life" side of this issue and we are standing with the Franklin Life Center. Although it may seem we ourselves may have major

differences on this topic, we agree more than you might think. Let's look at some points of agreement. Almost all of us agree that abortion beyond 6 months of the pregnancy is wrong. Almost all of us agree that a baby is a soul and a gift from God and this soul should be considered in any abortion decision. A final important point is the decision to abort should only be seriously considered if continuing the pregnancy will endanger the life of the mother and the decision needs to be supported by a doctor.

If you insist on forcing a new life on a mother, you better be ready to address some other serious questions such as - How will the mother support this new life? Does the mother have the knowledge to raise a child? Will this have a drastic negative result on the mother's life? The Venango County Christian community can and should address these important concerns.

The Franklin Life Center offers the support, knowledge and a message of Christ as the giver of life. The Life Center needs our full support as this topic becomes front page in the media. Please pray about giving generously to the center during this time and if you are led, donate your time to helping the Life staff. In every crisis, God gives us an opportunity to serve.


