Scripture

Acts 4:23-31 After the apostles have been commanded not to preach about Jesus and threatened if they do so, they lead this prayer within the church. The prayer asks God to “enable your servants to speak boldly.” They intend to do what they know Christ has commanded them. And to authenticate their message with signs and wonders. They do not pray for protection, but for faithfulness, determination and courage.

1 Timothy 2:1-6a Paul urges prayer for all people including rulers. (This is a pattern for our prayers for political and cultural leaders in our time). He connects these prayers to two results: the ability to live peacefully, and the salvation of all who will come to Christ.

James 5:16b “The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.” Prayer is powerful. Use it. Seek righteousness so your prayers are not hindered.

for Steadfast Leaders

Father God, everyone in leadership can feel overwhelmed by the global pandemic; the illness, death, and economic downturns that have resulted, and the burdens of decision making. Strengthen each leader with resolve to serve the common good. May they not be distracted or discouraged by the headlines or political pressures they face.
