



Grace Church family,

I'm a porch person! I love front porches and back porches. I have great memories of "porch life." When I was a kid, I would often visit my grandparents and sit with them on their front porch. We'd listen to the Pirate games, eat Grandma's snacks, and they'd talk to the neighbors. I think we've neglected porches these days.



Do you know there's a connection between porches and discipleship?

When the founder of the Methodist movement, John Wesley, described a person's growth as a follower of Jesus he used the images of a porch and a house.

"Our main doctrines, which include all the rest, are three, that of repentance, of faith, and of holiness. The first of these we account, as it were, the porch of religion; the next, the door; the third is religion itself." (John Wesley)

The porch can be a welcoming place. In salvation and discipleship, the porch is where people are welcomed; hospitality shown; introductions made. But for Wesley, the porch is also the place where people see their need for repentance. It's where confession of sins take place. The porch is the place of *prevenient grace*. God is calling us to the porch!

But in God's goodness, he doesn't leave people on the porch. He invited us all into his house. Moving into the house means taking a step over the threshold. It is an intentional movement from porch to house. Wesley compared this step over the threshold to *justifying grace*. You and I accept the invitation into the house, into God's home. Into life with God. Stepping over the threshold means confessing our sins, saying 'yes' to Jesus and, in that moment – knowing we've been forgiven, redeemed, justified, and adopted as children of God. Good news!

But there is so much more in the house. Wesley would say that being in God's house is a life of *sanctifying grace*. This is where most of our life with God is spent. Living in God's house is a life of discipleship in which we grow in holiness of heart and life. Living with God changes you and me. We become like Jesus.

We've been on a journey -A Disciple's Path. It won't be a one-time journey - it's our life with Jesus. Along this journey we've been discovering and practicing habits/disciplines which other Methodist Christians have been practicing for centuries. These habits (prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness) shape us to become more like Jesus. God invites us into his house and shapes us with these habits.

How has our *Path* been going for you? What are you learning? But more importantly, what are you practicing? Where have you seen God at work in your life and in the community of Grace Church? Are you getting comfortable in God's house? What's your next, right step?


Living On Purpose,


